**NOTICE OF CHANGES TO BANKRUPTCY COURT MISCELLANEOUS FEE SCHEDULE
EFFECTIVE DECEMBER 1, 2013**

The Judicial Conference has made several changes to the Bankruptcy Court Miscellaneous Fee Schedule that will become effective on December 1, 2013.

First, the Court **will charge \$176 for the filing of any motion to sell property of the estate free and clear of liens under 11 U.S.C. §363(f)**. Case trustees: at present no national or local rule defers payment if the trustee files the motion and the estate has no funds. However, the Judges will entertain motions to defer payment of the fee for case trustees only. A trustee seeking deferral should file a Motion to Defer Filing Fee (using the Motion for Authority event) which provides for payment of the deferred fee from sale proceeds.

Second, the cost to retrieve one box from the Federal Records Center, National Archives or other storage location removed from the place of business of the Court increases from \$53 to \$64 AND the cost for each additional box retrieved will be \$39. (Previously, no additional fee was charged regardless of the number of boxes retrieved.)

Finally, the schedule is clarified to provide that any payment returned or denied for insufficient funds, not just checks, will result in a fee of \$53.
