

Docket Summary Report re: Bug Fix (WO 5579) [All Users]

A bug was found in the Docket Summary Report, which is a report run by outside users to view activity on cases in which they are involved. The program set both the Summary Text and Full Text radio buttons behind the scenes, but on the screen it appeared that only the Full Text radio button was selected. Selecting the Summary Text button caused an error on the report. The program has been fixed and users may now select either button.

Updated Form Orders (WO 5079) [All Users]

The form orders issued on motions to pay in installment fees and motions to waive chapter 7 filing fees have been updated to clarify the location of the Clerk's address and the method of payment; i.e., cash, check, debit card, etc.

Follow-Up to Local Rule Changes (WO 5491) [All Users]

The Motion for Turnover and Notice of Turnover events have been added to the motions and notices menus, respectively. These events may only be accessed by trustees and their attorneys, and an updated message refers other users to Fed.R.Bankr.P. 7001(1). Local Rule B-7027-1 was removed during the recent rules update, so the Motion for Leave to File Pursuant to Local Rule S.D.Ind. B-7027-1 event has been retired.

Plan Distribution; Motions to Modify (WO 5531) [All Users] - This WO will be moved to LIVE on 10/31/12.

The plan and related noticing events have been updated so plans filed in the Indianapolis office can be distributed by the trustees or debtors. The Motion to Modify Plan Post-Confirmation event was updated to set a certificate of service due date when the motion is filed by the trustee and the notice has not yet been served. The Notice on Motion to Modify Plan Post-Confirmation event was updated to auto-terminate the certificate of service deadline.

Bad/Updated Address Notice vs. Return Mail Notice (WO 5553) [Trustees and Court Users]

The Trustee's Notice of Bad/Updated Address event has been retired as the Clerk's Office will no longer be updating creditor addresses or removing creditors from the matrix. If trustees want to report that mail has been returned to their office for a specific creditor, they can use the Return Mail Notice event which does not require a PDF to be uploaded (i.e., it's a docket only notice). The event, which is auto-QCed, can be found on the Trustee/US Trustee and Trustee's Batch Filing menus.

Signed Orders Report Error (WO 5571) [Court Users]

An error with the Signed Orders Report occurred recently, and the problem was traced to docketing an order on an adversary proceeding where the plaintiff's name included a generation (e.g., Jr., Sr., II, etc.). The program has been fixed and the error should no longer occur.

Form Error re: "No Forms Processed" (WO 5356) [Court Users]

Earlier this year a few forms weren't generated and also didn't end up in Generate Notices. Debugging statements were added to the program and the situation was monitored. After making a few adjustments, the problems have been resolved and the debugging statements have been removed.

Deficiency Notices re: Misspelled Word (WO 5576) [Court Users]

A spelling error was found in the Petition Deficiency Notice and Adversary Deficiency Notice events. The misspelling has been corrected.

EditAutoAssign re: Judge Assignment (WO 5021) [Court Users]

With new judges arriving soon, the EditAutoAssign function will be used to transfer cases between judges. The function and related programs have been modified to work correctly.

Agreed Entry SDO re: Add Stipulation Option (WO 5541) [Courtroom Deputies]

The Order Approving Agreed Entry SDO event has been updated to allow users to add either "agreed entry" or "stipulation" to docket text by selecting a radio button.
