

## **Order Distribution re: Certificates of Service (WO 5582) [All Users]**

The distribution statement added to docket text and some orders will be modified to leave out reference to filing a certificate of service.

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## **Docket Summary Report re: Bug Fix (WO 5590) [Outside Users]**

The Docket Summary Report (available on the Utilities menu under the Your Account heading) provides non-court users a way to obtain case activity when their email goes down and they don't receive Notices of Electronic Filing (NEFs) from the court. The report has been updated to be more user friendly. As well as selecting a date range, users can now include subaccounts (extra accounts assigned to some outside users), and select start and end times (if start time is blank, default is midnight; if end time is blank, default is 11:59:59 p.m.). Also, the default setting was changed from Summary Text to Full Text so users will always see the entire docket text entry unless they change the default back to Summary Text.

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## **Deficient Motions to Modify Plan Post-Confirmation (WO 5591) [All Users]**

If a motion to modify plan post-confirmation is deficient, the deficiency notice will give the filer 7 days to correct the deficiency rather than the usual 14 days.

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## **Remove Limit Notice Flag Upon Conversion (WO 5437) [All Users]**

When notice is limited for all notices issued on a case, the limit notice flag (LimitNtc) is set. When a case converts, notices are no longer limited under the new chapter. (A new request to limit notice must be filed.) Conversion events have been updated to auto-remove the LimitNtc flag upon conversion.

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## **Motions to Reopen re: Updated Message Concerning Reaffirmation Agreements (WO 5518) [All Users]**

A motion to reopen is required if a reaffirmation agreement is being filed on a closed case and that agreement will require a hearing or order. The message concerning reaffirmation agreements and motions to reopen has been clarified so users know when a motion is not required; i.e., reaffirmation agreements that don't require a hearing or order.

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## **Limited Notice re: No Asset Cases (WO 5520) [Court Users]**

If a no asset case is pending more than 90 days after the first date set for the meeting of creditors, notices required per Fed.R.Bankr.P. 2002(a) are limited to claimants and case participants. A message will display when notice should be limited.

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## **Case Opening re: Bug Fix (WO 5568) [Court Users]**

An SQL error was being logged from the Judge/Trustee Assignment program. Changes were made to eliminate the errors.

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## **CRD Email re: Objections to Relief from Stay when Filer Refuses to Waive Time Requirements (WO 5326) [Courtroom Services]**

When an objection to a motion for relief from stay is filed, an email will be auto-sent to the CRD if the filer of the motion refused to waive the time requirements.

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## **Event Change re: Close Case Without Discharge (WO 5489) [Case Managers]**

The Close Case Without Discharge event has been updated so it can be used to close chapter 7 asset cases as well as chapter 7 no asset cases. When a chapter 7 asset case is closed with this event, docket text will reflect that the trustee has been discharged.

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## **Maintain User Accounts (WO 5586) [User Registration Group]**

The Bar Status field in a user record will be used to indicate why a user is locked out of ECF. Two new statuses have been added: Terminated, No Original. Also, the training field found on the More Information screen will now read "INSB Training Date" rather than "ECF Training Date". Finally, a message to locked-out users has been updated to reference the correct email address to contact for lock out issues.

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
