

## **Changes to Chapter 11 Voluntary Petition Event (WO 5680) [All Users]**

- The filing fee for a chapter 11 railroad case is \$1046, but all non-railroad cases are \$1213. Event has been updated to charge the correct fee for railroads.
  - When the debtor fails to file Schedule D with the petition, the List of Secured Creditors is due within 7 days of filing. The event incorrectly set a 3 day due date, but has now been updated to correctly set the 7 day due date.

## **Retention of Noticing, Balloting, or Claims Agents (WO 5597) [All Users]**

A new motion event and related order event have been created to address the retention of noticing, balloting, or claims agents pursuant to Local Rule S.D.Ind. B-1007-2. The Motion for Case Management Order has been updated to include a message to utilize the new event if the only issues to be resolved are the retention of agents. Both motion events send an email to the Clerk as filers are required to consult the Clerk prior to filing the motion. Each agent type has a corresponding flag, and those flags are set upon entry of the order.

## **Waived Filing Fees & Changes to Fee Function (WO 5507) [All Users]**

The Order on Motion to Waive Chapter 7 Filing Fees has been updated to add the amount of the filing fee to docket text. The fee function has been updated to look to a table listing current fees, rather than hard coding the fees in events. This change will simplify the process for updating fees in ECF when fees increase.

## **Add Document # to Utility Events (WO 2782) [Court Users]**

The following utility events have been updated to allow case managers to relate the utility event to another event when necessary: Attorney – Add, Attorney – Terminate, Document – Terminate, Motion – Terminate, Party – Add, Party – Terminate.

## **Add Link to Open Transfer Case Event (WO 5641) [Court Users]**

The Open Transfer Case event has been updated to add a link to the Procedures Manual on how to attach documents on cases received from another District.

## **Order Distribution re: Bug Fix (WO 5619) [Courtroom Services]**

A bug in the order distribution program has been corrected. SDOs will no longer fail when a case has more than one creditor/attorney. The recipient list will no longer be displayed when issuing a local form or a form to be distributed by an outside user.
