

## **Motion to Incur Debt re: Updated Local Rule S.D. Ind. B-4001-3 (WO 5545) [All Users]**

The Motion to Incur Debt event has been updated to match the changes to the local rule which go into effect 2/19/13. Users will now be asked if the trustee's consent has been obtained. If so, the consent must be attached to the motion, or the event sets a 14-day objection time for the trustee.

## **Trustees' 341 Grid re: Duplicate Entries (WO 5401) [Trustees]**

Occasionally, an item filed from the trustees' 341 grid was duplicated, including any deadlines that might be set. The bug was found and corrected, and the 341 grid no longer creates duplicate entries.

## **Motion to Dismiss Adversary Proceeding Filed by Defendant (WO 5686) [Law Clerks, Courtroom Services]**

The law clerks requested an automatic email when the defendant files a motion to dismiss an adversary proceeding. The event has been updated to issue an email to the JudgeJKC, JudgeRLM, JudgeFJO, and JudgeJMC email groups.

## **Signed Docket Orders and Missing Filers (WO 5650) [Courtroom Services]**

Most signed docket orders (SDOs) include the filing information from the related docket entry, and if the filing information is missing, the SDO fails. Recently, it was discovered that all entries docketed from the trustees' 341 grids do not include the trustee as the filing party (behind the scenes). The grid has been updated and now a trustee is always added as the filing party, and SDOs related to grid entries should no longer fail.

## **Server Error Received from Signed Orders Report (WO 5610) [Court Users]**

Two motions were filed together in one entry which caused an error on the Signed Orders Report. The problem has been fixed, and a server error is no longer received.

## **Generate Notices re: Undeleting Error (WO 5688) [Court Users]**

When a form request was deleted, the form was automatically undeleted when any Generate Notices option (i.e., send to BNC, issue local form, etc.) was selected. The bug has been fixed, and a form is now only undeleted when the Undelete option is selected.

## **Emails to Corrections (WO 5691) [Court Users]**

When a document needs to be removed from ECF per an order, an email was sent to a corrections email group based on the office where the case was filed. Now that case management work is distributed district wide, it was decided that the email should go to one corrections email group containing all team leaders and supervisors. The event has been updated, and an email is sent to the new group when documents need to be removed/deleted for protective orders, orders to remove documents, and orders to restrict public access.

## **Order Reopening Case Closed Without Discharge (WO 5695) [Court Users]**

When an order reopening is entered on a case closed without discharge, the user is asked if the case is being reopened to issue the discharge. Answering “yes” skips over the option to reappoint the trustee. Since chapter 12 or 13 cases closed without discharge might need the trustee reappointed, the Order on Motion to Reopen Bankruptcy Case event has been updated to only ask the “issue the discharge” question on chapter 7 cases.

## **Notice of No Discharge re: Updates (WO 5677) [Court Users]**

The Notice of No Discharge event and form have been updated to correctly display information when the notice is issued on a chapter 12 case. A form was also updated to correctly display the date an order revoking or denying a discharge was entered.
