

Order Upload Link (WO 4591) [All Users]

A link to Order Upload will be available after a motion is filed. By using the new link, the case number and related document number are automatically included in the upload process. Outside users will only see the link when an order is required, but the link will display for all motions docketed by court users. NOTE: Uploaded orders are not required on motions for which the court uses standard form orders.

Order Upload Error (WO 5705) [Judges]

A bug was discovered in the order upload program that prevented judges from uploading orders. The program has been updated, and judges may now upload orders with no problems.

Order Activity Report re: Remove Routing Actions (WO 5702) [Judges]

Non-configured routing actions were displayed for judges when signing orders. The routing actions – Deny, Dismissed, Moot, Sign-Other, Withdrawn – have been removed.

Auto-QCing of Creditors (WO 5454) [Court Users]

Creditors added through events such as Requests for Notice and Amended Schedules will be auto-QCed as case managers no longer need to review these added creditors.

Changes to Docket Activity Report (WO 5454) [Court Users]

The Edit Summary of Schedules and Remove SD Codes buttons have been removed from the Docket Activity Report as case managers no longer need to review the schedule summary and SD codes are no longer removed.

Judge Metz Assigned to New Cases (WO 5643) [Court Users]

An error in the Judge/Trustee Assignment program caused retired Judge Metz to be assigned to new cases. A temporary patch was added in December 2012 which seems to be solving the problem. The patch is now permanent, but Tim will continue to monitor error logs to ensure judge assignment is working correctly.
