

## **Stipulation Events (WO 5657) [All Users]**

The generic stipulation event has been updated to display a message about the various other stipulation and agreed entry events that should be used for filing. Two new stipulation events are now available: Stipulation of Facts/Documents, Stipulation of Dismissal of Appeal.

## **Notice of Impending Closure Without Discharge re: Chapter 13 Cases (WO 5666) [All Users]**

The Clerk's Office sent this notice to chapter 13 debtors who didn't file documents required to receive a discharge. Since the trustee's Notice of Plan Completion includes the list of required documents, the Clerk's Office will discontinue sending this redundant notice.

## **Wage Assignment Orders re: Distribution (WO 5665) [All Users]**

The wage assignment order events – including the order terminating wage assignment – weren't set up correctly as to distribution; i.e., the trustee or debtors' attorney were required to distribute the order to the employer, but the Clerk's Office was still sending a copy of the order to the debtors through the BNC. The events have been updated to require the trustee or the debtors' attorney to distribute the order to all parties, including the debtors. Trustees are required to distribute all wage assignment orders entered on pro se cases.

## **Closing an Asset Case re: Discharging the Trustee (WO 5731) [Court Users]**

When an asset case is closed, docket text includes language discharging the trustee. Recently, a reopened case was reclosed and the trustee discharge language was added to docket text, even though the trustee had not been reappointed when the case was reopened. The closing event has been updated to ask the user if the trustee was reappointed; if so, trustee discharge language is added to docket text. NOTE: Question will only appear for reopened cases.

## **Extension Order re: Docket Text Problem (WO 5717) [Court Users]**

The Order on Motion to Extend Time to File Complaint event has options to set real deadlines or docket-text-only deadlines, depending upon the circumstances. For example, if an objection to discharge deadline was previously set on a case for July 2013 and a request is filed to extend the discharge deadline to June 2013, a docket-text only deadline is set and the later deadline isn't terminated. Docket text wasn't uniform when displaying the real deadlines and docket-text-only deadlines, so docket text has been updated and now displays the deadline information uniformly.
