

## **Block Scheduling in Terre Haute and Evansville Divisions (WO 5704) [All Users]**

The Block Scheduling program has been in place in the Indianapolis Division for a number of years, and the New Albany Division uses the program in a limited capacity (i.e., the chapter 13 trustee block schedules objections to the trustee's motions to dismiss). Block Scheduling is now coming to the Terre Haute and Evansville Divisions. Most hearings set through Block Scheduling are initiated by the chapter 13 trustee, but the debtors' and creditors' attorneys will schedule certain objections. For more information, click here. ## **New Electronic Process for Filing/Amending/Withdrawing Claims (WO 5783) [All Users]**

Two electronic filing programs are available for filing and amending proofs of claim (ePOC) and withdrawing proofs of claim (eWOC). Users do not need a login and password to use either program, and proof of claim forms do not need to be prepared ahead of time. The ePOC program automatically creates and files the proof of claim during the process. Users will still need to prepare a PDF document to withdraw a claim through eWOC, but won't need a login and password. A new fillable Notice of Withdrawal of Claim form is available on our website.

## **Electronic CM/ECF Registration (WO 4886) [All Users]**

A new electronic program for processing CM/ECF registration requests for both attorneys and limited users is being implemented. All users requesting a CM/ECF login and password must now use the new program. The upper left hand corner of our website has been modified to include a link to the new registration program. In conjunction with the new registration program, a new online training program is also available.

## **Court's Notice of Possible Assets (WO 5631) [Court Users]**

The Notice of Possible Assets event has been updated so a new claims deadline is not set if this notice is issued more than once. A message is displayed for case managers when the deadline won't be set. A new option to add "Amended" to both docket text and the form is now available, but only displays if this notice has been previously issued. Also, if an amended notice is issued after the claims deadline has expired, that fact is reflected on the form.
