

Orders Extending Time to File (WO 4672) [All Users]

An order extending time to file generally applies to the filing party only. Docket text and standard court orders now state “as to filing party only” or “as to Trustee and U.S. trustee only”, depending upon who filed the extension motion. Court users now have the option to terminate previously set extension deadlines.

Application for Waiver of Chapter 7 Filing Fee (WO 5681) [All Users]

Although this event should only be used to request waiver of the chapter 7 filing fee, users often use the event to request waiver of other fees. To prevent the event from being used in error, users are now stopped from filing the event in a case if it is not a “waiver” case based on the fee status.

Cost of Administration Order (WO 5644) [Trustees, Court Users]

The Cost of Administration Order, now issued by case managers, is only issued to trustees in asset cases where part of the filing fee has been waived or if the trustee will need to make installment fee payments. The COA no longer includes the amount due, so trustees will need to contact the court about the exact amount due.

Order Denying Agreed Entry re: Motion to Modify Required (WO 5594) [Courtroom Services, Chambers]

A standard order is now available if the Court determines that a motion to modify plan post-confirmation should have been filed instead of an agreed entry. The order denies the agreed entry and instructs the filer to file a motion to modify. Courtroom deputies access the new order from the Agreed Entry/Stipulation – Approving or Denying event.

Order on Motion to Restrict Public Access (WO 5719) [Courtroom Services]

This event has been updated to allow courtroom deputies to enter an SDO which will list the documents to be restricted.

Order Extending Time to File Miscellaneous Documents re: Deadline (WO 5873) [Court Users]

Users have the option to set either a CRD deadline or CM deadline when an extension of time is granted for miscellaneous documents. The variable statement asking users to select the appropriate deadline has been clarified. Users may also terminate previously set extension deadlines.
