

Adversary Proceedings Filed by Trustees (WO 5818) [Trustees, Court Users]

When a trustee files a new adversary proceeding, the trustee person record will be automatically added as the plaintiff. The purpose of the change is to ensure that trustees will receive NEFs for new adversaries without filing an appearance, and the plaintiff will no longer show up as a pro se party.

New and Updated Events re: Recommendations from ECF Advisory Committee (WO 5748) [All Users]

The following events have been added to ECF: Motion and Order to Estimate Claims; Motion, Notice and Order to Allow Interest, Fees, and Costs; Satisfaction of Judgment; and Consent to Entry of Order for Relief. The Amended/Corrected Petition event was updated to allow use with Involuntary Petitions. The radio button list in the Motion for Protective Order event has been updated to include Fed.R.Bankr.P. 7026(c) as an option. The Interrogatories and Notice of Filing of Deposition events were retired as these documents should not be filed as stand-alone documents.

Withdraw Document Event re: New Warning Message (WO 5784) [All Users]

A warning message is now displayed in the Withdraw Document event when the party filing the withdrawal is not the same party who filed the document being withdrawn. The purpose is to help cut down on incorrectly withdrawn documents.

Motion to Avoid Wholly Unsecured Mortgage (WO 5913) [All Users]

This event has been renamed Motion to Avoid Wholly Unsecured Mortgage/Lien [Section 1322(b)(2)] for clarification purposes.

Installment Fee Deadline, Flag, and Fee Status (WO 5652) [Court Users]

The Installment Fee Payment event has been updated to automatically terminate the installment fee payment deadline, remove the FeeDueINST flag, and change the fee status from installments to completed payments when an attorney makes the final installment fee payment. Case managers will still have to remove the flag for pro se debtors who pay over the counter. When the flag is removed, the deadline is terminated and the fee status is updated.

Notice of Prior Discharge re: Chapter 13 Debtors (WO 4724) [Court Users]

The Prior Bankruptcy Case utility event and notice have been updated to only send the notice to pro se chapter 13 debtors when they are ineligible to receive a discharge pursuant to 11 U.S.C. Section 1328(f). Previously, a generic version of the notice was issued to all pro se chapter 13 debtors with a prior discharge, regardless of eligibility status.

Events Removed from CSPriority List (WO 5310) [Courtroom Services]

The following events are no longer needed on the CSPriority List on the Docket Activity Report and have been removed from the list: Motion to Convert, Motion to Deem Mortgage Current, Motion to Incur Debt, Motion to Modify Secured Debt, Objection to Claim, and Trustee's Report of Settlement.

Motion for Ex Parte Relief (WO 5871) [Judges]

This motion and related order were restricted to users in the E-Orders Signers group, but new judges are no longer automatically added to that group and therefore couldn't view ex parte motions or orders. The events were updated to add a Judges group to the restricted list so judges may view these documents.
