

Mediation Events (WO 5984) [All Users]

The Notice of Selection of Mediator event has been updated to allow the relationship to a previously entered order to be optional rather than mandatory. The Mediator's Final Report event has been updated to always remove the MEDIATION flag.

Miscellaneous Updates re: ECF Advisory Committee (WO 5748) [All Users]

The ECF Advisory Committee recommended the following changes:

- Motion to Compel: A link to Local Rule B-7037-1 was added to the event.
 - Motion to Convert: Event was added to the File Pleadings in an Involuntary Case menu.
 - Motion for Sanctions: Event was removed from the Discovery menu.
 - Motion to Determine Transferee's Rights Pursuant to Fed.R.Bankr.P. 3001(e)(3): New event added along with corresponding order event.
 - Request for Production or Inspection of Documents: Event retired. Filers should use either the Motion to Compel or Motion for Turnover event.

Schedules and Amended Schedules re: Added Creditors (WO 5974) [Court Users]

The Schedules and Amended Schedules events have been updated for court users to remove the question concerning added creditors. The Add Creditor function has also been removed from the event.

Electronic Exhibits re: Judge Moberly (WO 5986) [Court Users]

Judge Moberly will begin conducting hearings where the exhibits will be created as PDF files and emailed to the courtroom deputy prior to the hearing. After the hearing, the courtroom deputy will docket both admitted and offered exhibits using one of two new events: Admitted Exhibits or Offered Exhibits.

Involuntary Case Filed by Pro Se Petitioning Creditor (WO 4723) [Court Users]

When a court user opens an involuntary case filed by a pro se creditor, the debtor's name is entered as "Sealed", and the file is forwarded to the assigned judge to determine if the involuntary case should proceed. The message displayed during case opening has been updated slightly to inform court users to add "Sealed" as the debtor name, to select the county of residence, and to not add any further address information to the debtor record.
