## **District Court Order re: Appeals/Withdrawals of Reference (WO 5966) [Court Users]**

This order event has been updated to correctly display withdrawal of reference information in docket text and to add “Acknowledgement of Dismissal” as a ruling option.

## **Editing Docket Entries (WO 6003) [Court Users]**

Case managers cannot edit docket entries entered by court users, which is a problem when Financial Management Certificates are filed incorrectly from the eFinCert program. Entries from the eFinCert program are considered docketed by the Administrator, which is a court user account. The program has been updated, and case managers can now edit any docket entry docketed by the Administrator account.
