

Motion to Incur Debt (WO 5994) [All Users]

This event asks filers if the trustee has given consent to incur the debt. Trustees in the Indianapolis division require that their written consent be filed with the motion. Trustees in other divisions allow filers to include a statement that the trustee has consented without getting their signature. The motion event has been updated to clarify the different requirements per office.

Certificate of Service for Chapter 13 Plan Notice (WO 6013) [Court Users]

When the debtor fails to file a certificate of service for the chapter 13 plan notice, a 7-day notice of incomplete filing is issued. Case managers will now monitor that deadline and inform courtroom deputies if debtors fail to file certificates of service.

Motion to Compromise and Settle (WO 6014) [Chambers and CRDs]

This event has been updated to always send an email to chambers/CRDs upon filing. Previously, an email was only sent if the motion was NOT filed pursuant to Fed.R.Bankr.P. 9019.

Order Terminating Wage Assignment (WO 6015) [Case Managers]

During docketing, this order is related to the original Wage Assignment (WA). If there is only one WA on the docket, the Order Terminating Wage Assignment (OTWA) event does not display the related entry, and case managers do not have access to the employer's name without returning to the docket. The OTWA event has been updated to always display the related WA, so the employer's name is easily found.
