

Events with Deadlines re: Closed Cases (WO 5927) [All Users]

Since new deadlines should not be set on closed cases, a new program has been put in place to remove filing access for outside users to any event that sets a deadline. Users are warned that the case is closed, and that events that set deadlines – such as lien avoidance motions – will not be available for filing until the case has been reopened. Court users are instructed to consult their team leader before docketing any pleading that would normally set a deadline.

Creditor Count re: Bug Fix (WO 6047) [All Users]

A creditor count is added to the top of the docket report so the court can monitor the number of creditors added to a case. Once a chapter 11 case exceeds 300 creditors, the debtor is required to employ noticing, balloting, and claims agents pursuant to S.D.Ind. B-1007-2. Recently, it was found that terminated creditor records were being included in the count. That problem has been fixed and terminated creditor records are no longer counted.

Create Filing Fee Event (WO 6007) [Court Users]

A new utility event – Fee Due (Create Outstanding Fee) – has been created that allows court users to set up fees so outside users may pay the outstanding fee online. This event can be used to set up fees that were not created due to a processing error or if the fees were removed erroneously. The event is auto-QCed and will not show up in CMAssist.

Bulk Removal of Documents with Personal Identifiers (WO 6010) [Court Users]

Parties who have filed multiple (e.g., hundreds of) documents containing personal identifiers can contact the court about using an automated program to remove the original documents and auto-file replacement documents. The program was originally set up to process claims only, but it has now been updated to process other types of documents. The process of removing and refileing documents is started with the filing of a miscellaneous case and submission of a data file set up per the program's requirements.
