## **Supplemental Schedules I/J re: Chapter 13 Cases (WO 5995) [All Users]**

The official forms for Schedules I and J were updated last year to allow chapter 13 debtors to file supplements to their original schedules if their income or expenses have changed post-petition. A new event -- Schedule(s) I/J - Supplement Showing Post-Petition Income/Expenses -- is now available to file the supplemental schedules.

## **Motions to Sell (WO 6039) [Trustees]**

The Motion to Sell event has been updated to give attorneys for trustees the option to pay the filing fee during filing.

## **Notice of Incomplete Filing re: Pro Se Parties (WO 6034) [Court Users]**

The Notice of Incomplete Filing event has been updated to allow court users to issue the notice through the BNC to any pro se party. Previously, the notice could only be sent to the BNC for pro se debtors.

## **Auto-Select Trustee on Converted Cases (WO 6030) [341 Calendaring Clerks]**

The event used to terminate and add a new trustee and issue the 341 meeting notice on converted cases has been updated to automatically select a new trustee and set the 341 meeting date for chapter 7 and 13 cases. Previously, 341 calendaring clerks had to manually update the trustee records and issue the 341 notice.

## **Conversion to Chapter 11 Re: Dischargeability Deadline (WO 6063) [341 Calendaring Clerks]**

The Objection to Dischargeability deadline should be set for chapter 11 cases, but the 341 meeting notice issued on a case converted to a chapter 11 set the wrong deadline. The deadline has been fixed, and the 341 notice now displays the correct deadline.

## **Notice of Teleconference re: Attorney Name (WO 6064) [Courtroom Deputies]**

This notice includes the name of the attorney who will be initiating the teleconference. When more than one attorney represents a party, the names are listed alphabetically by first name, and the notice picks up the first attorney name listed, rather than the attorney who filed the pleading that set the teleconference. The notice has been updated to always add the filing attorney to the notice.
