

Objection to Claim re: UST Flag (WO 6122) [U.S. Trustee]

The Objection to Claim event has been updated to change the UST flag to yes.

Batch Order Upload (WO 6117) [Trustees]

When an error occurs during Batch Order Upload, an error message is displayed warning the user to verify that the upload was processed correctly. The message has been updated to give more information about how to go about verifying that the order was uploaded.

Certificate of Service Dates (WO 5618) [All Users]

In several events users are asked to enter the date notices were served on parties, and the objection deadline is then calculated from the service date. Sometimes users enter an older date in error -- especially during the first few months of a new year -- which causes the objection deadline to be set in the past. A programming change has been made to prevent users from entering a date more than 60 days in the past which should eliminate most user errors.

Intervenors in Adversary Proceedings (WO 6041) [All Users]

An intervenor in an adversary proceeding must file a Motion to Intervene, unless the filer is the trustee in the related bankruptcy case. Recently, appearances have been filed on behalf of intervenors, but motions were not filed. A message has been added to the Appearance event reminding filers about the need to file the motion if a role type of "intervenor" is selected for the party they are representing. Courtroom deputies will monitor the filing of the motion using a new intervenor deadline.

Events to Continue or Set Hearing or Trial (WO 6099) [All Users]

The Motion to Continue Hearing and Motion to Set Hearing events have been updated to add an option for continuing or setting a trial. The events are now called Motion to Continue Hearing or Trial and Motion to Set Hearing or Trial. The corresponding order events have been updated to allow court users to continue or set hearings or trials.

Order on Motion to Consolidate or Jointly Administer Cases (WO 6100) [All Users]

When an order denying a motion to consolidate or jointly administer cases is entered, the document number of the related motion now appears in docket text.

Brief Event re: Adversary Proceedings (WO 6114) [All Users]

The Brief event has been updated to change the Trial or Post-Trial Brief radio button into two radio buttons; e.g., Pretrial Brief, Post-Trial Brief.

Order Upload re: Attachments (WO 6115) [All Users]

All orders uploaded in ECF are processed through a PDF verification program before being accepted. The order must conform to font and size requirements. Recently, a user tried to upload an order with an attachment that was set up in landscape mode, and the PDF verification program rejected the order. The program has been updated to only review the first page of the order so that attachments can be uploaded in landscape mode.

Response Event re: Plans (WO 6119) [All Users]

Users often use the Response event instead of the Objection event, and the events are set up similarly, but recently a discrepancy between the events was found. The Response event has been updated to match the Objection event by adding a message that any objections to plans must be filed using the appropriate objection event (e.g., Objection to Plan, Objection to Amended Plan, etc.).

Streamline ECF Announcement Posting (WO 6070) [Systems]

Programming changes have been made to streamline posting of new announcements on the ECF landing page seen by outside filers.
