

Motion to Set Aside Clerk's Entry of Default (WO 5990) [All Users]

This new motion event is now available for filing in adversary proceedings. A corresponding order event is also available.

Cross- and Counterclaims re: Required Deadlines (WO 6088) [All Users]

When a cross-claim is filed, an answer is due within 21 days after service, and if the United States is involved, an answer is due from the government within 35 days after service. When a counterclaim is filed, a reply is due within 21 days after service, and if the United States is involved, a reply is due from the government within 35 days after service. The Cross-Claim and Counterclaim events, as well as all adversary answer events, have been updated to set the appropriate deadlines.

Debtor Name Displayed Next to Case Number Field (WO 6055) [All Users]

The case name now appears next to any case number text box once a valid case number is entered into the text box. The same behavior holds true on screens where multiple case numbers can be entered, like Batch Order Upload. Clicking the Active box also triggers the case name being displayed next to the case number text box. This new feature is especially helpful on the Create Calendar Event for a Case Screen where deadlines can be added to cases.

Generic SDO re: Bug Fix (WO 6130) [Courtroom Services]

An isolated problem with the generic SDO form (sgeneric) has been fixed. If the form was related to an Application for Compensation, none of the usual form information was entered on the order; i.e., all the fields showed "Missing" and the form couldn't be generated.

Next Button re: Bug Fix (WO 6084) [Court Users]

On the Generate Test Form Screen, the Next button remained active even if there was no case number in the case number field. Clicking on the Next button in this situation caused an error. The program has been updated, and the Next button is now only active if a case number has been entered.
