

## **IRS Automated Claim Filing Program (WO 6142) [IRS]**

Changes to the case number text box caused problems for the IRS when trying to file claims using their automated claim filing program. Issues have been resolved and the IRS can now use their program without receiving errors.

## **Debtor Name Displayed Next to Case Number Field (WO 6055) [All Users]**

The case name now appears next to any case number text box once a valid case number is entered into the text box. The same behavior holds true on screens where multiple case numbers can be entered, like Batch Order Upload. Clicking the Active box also triggers the case name being displayed next to the case number text box. This new feature is especially helpful on the Create Calendar Event for a Case Screen where deadlines can be added to cases.

## **Certificate of Service Event (WO 6165) [All Users]**

The Certificate of Service event has been updated so that it may be related to more than one entry.

## **Filing Fee Query re: Bug Fix (WO 6143) [All Users]**

If more than one payment record was associated with the same docket entry, the fees were not displayed correctly under the Filing Fee Query. This problem has been fixed, and fees now display correctly.

## **Browse Button Defaults re: IE10 (WO 6161) [All Users]**

Users who have upgraded to IE10 have encountered problems while browsing for files to upload to ECF; i.e., the browse window defaults to “image” files instead of “all” files. A function causing the problem has been removed from the appropriate ECF program, and the browse window now defaults to “all” files.

## **Updated Message and Rule Citations (WO 6163) [All Users]**

A message in the Chapter 7 Involuntary Petition event pointed users to the incorrect menu selection for the Corporate Ownership Statement, and several events contained an incorrect abbreviation for the Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure (FRBP instead of Fed.R.Bankr.P.). The message and rule citations have been updated.

## **Order on Motion to Set Hearing or Trial (WO 6162) [Courtroom Services]**

This order event was recently updated to add radio buttons allowing users to set either a hearing or trial, and a typographical error was reported. The intro to the radio button option has been updated from “Motion seeks to continue....” to “Motion seeks to set....”.

## **Standardize Hyperlinks within Event (WO 3190) [Court Users]**

Hyperlinks are added to events to allow users to connect to the Procedures Manual or Local Rules. Events with an outdated hyperlink function have been updated to use the Link Docket Processing Function. The change is transparent to users.

## **Miscellaneous Dictionary and Programming Bug Fixes (WO 6146) [Court Users]**

Two bugs that caused behind-the-scenes problems have been corrected: 1) “lf2” statements within an “if” statement weren’t working correctly; and 2) an unused judge card was being created whenever a judge was assigned to a new chapter 11.
