

Exception to Filing Deadline Events on Closed Cases (WO 6184) [All Users]

The Exhibit D event can now be filed on closed cases. Previously, a deadline in the event prevented it from being selected by outside filers if the exhibit was being filed on a closed case.

Allow relating a document in the lead case to a document in a member case (WO 6091) [All Users]

A document being filed in the lead case of a jointly administered or consolidated case can now be related to a document already filed in a member case – necessary if the related document was filed before the cases became jointly administered or consolidated.

Cross Appeal event has been retired (WO 6208) [All Users]

Per new national rules, a cross appeal is immediately transmitted to District Court, who make the determination whether it is indeed a cross appeal in an existing appeal, or should be treated as a new appeal. As such, the regular Notice of Appeal event should be used if filing a cross appeal. The cross appeal event is therefore redundant and has been retired. All other events that make reference to cross appeals have been modified to remove those references.

Auto-docket plan notices (WO 5841) [Court Users]

A new routine now runs every night to automatically docket the plan objection notice on all eligible original and amended plans. This function is currently performed manually by case administrators.

Automatic e-mails on motions to sell (WO 6217) [Chambers]

An automatic e-mail is now sent to the relevant Chambers whenever any motion to sell is filed. Previously, this e-mail was only generated for a certain type of motion to sell.

Set UST flag on three events (WO 6210) [US Trustee]

A flag has been set behind the scenes in order to allow the US Trustee to receive PDFs for the following events:

- Motion for Authority
 - Order Granting Motion for Authority
 - Order Granting Application to Employ
