

Electronic Proof of Claim Program (ePOC) (WO 6234) [All Users]

When an ePOC filer selected either the trustee or debtor's attorney filing option, incorrect information was added to ECF. To resolve that problem and allow the Court to correctly identify when claims are filed on behalf of creditors, trustees and debtors' attorneys must file claims through ECF.

Claims and Debtors' Attorneys (WO 6237) [All Users]

The label identifying a claim filer as the debtor's attorney was not set up correctly, which left claim filer's role blank on the Claims Register and Claims Activity Report. The label has been updated and now correctly shows the claim filer's role.

Financial Management Requirement Notice (WO 6251) [All Users]

The Financial Management Requirement Notice was issued in error on cases where the Personal Financial Management Certificate had previously been filed. The auto-noticing program was updated to look for certificates filed through the eFinCert program; previously, the auto-noticing program only looked for certificates filed through ECF.

Auto-Closing Program re: Miscellaneous Motions (WO 6226) [Court Users]

The upcoming auto-closing program skips cases with pending motions, but some motion events are set up as "miscellaneous" motions (e.g., motion for proceedings supplemental, motion for contempt, etc.) and don't show up as pending motions, which would cause some cases to be auto-closed in error. The order events related to the "miscellaneous" motion events will be updated to terminate the motions, and the program will be updated to treat the "miscellaneous" motions as regular motions.
