

Voluntary Chapter 11 Deficiency Deadlines (WO 6249) [All Users]

Two deficiency deadlines, which are set when items are not filed during case opening, were only added to docket text and were omitted from the Petition Deficiency Notice. The Voluntary Chapter 11 Petition event has been updated to add the two deadlines – List of 20 Largest Unsecured Creditors and List of Secured Creditors – to the deficiency notice when the items are missing.

Issuing COAs on IFP and ReducedFee Cases (WO 6228) [Court Users]

When a case where the filing fee was waived or reduced is converted to an asset case, a Cost of Administration Order is issued to the trustee for the filing fee. The Notice of Possible Assets event has been updated to route case managers to the Cost of Administration Order event immediately after the notice is generated.

Adding Claims Agents (WO 6215) [Court Users]

When a claims agent is retained, the claims agent is added to the case as party. The two order events – Order on Motion for Case Management Order and Order on Motion to Retain Noticing, Balloting or Claims Agent – that approve retention of claims agents have been updated to route case managers to the Party – Add/Terminate event immediately after docketing the order.

Objection Notice re: Late Filed Claim Motion (WO 6263) [Court Users]

The Objection Notice event was set up to force users to select a claim number when issued on a Motion for Approval to Treat Late Filed Claim as Timely Filed, which caused the notice to fail on cases where a claims agent was retained. The event has been updated to skip the requirement to select a claim number on cases with a claims agent.
