

Pro Hac Vice Admission Fees (WO 6271) [All Users]

The fee for filing a Motion to Appear Pro Hac Vice is now paid to the Bankruptcy Court through pay.gov when the motion is filed. Previously, the fee was paid to District Court after filing the motion. This change is effective May 1st.

Debtor Electronic Bankruptcy Noticing (DeBN) (WO 6235) [All Users]

A new option is available for debtors to receive court-generated notices via email, rather than on paper. Information about the process and a fillable form will be available at <http://www.insb.uscourts.gov/> on Monday, May 4th.

Motions to Dismiss and Jointly Administered Cases (WO 6257) [All Users]

The Motion to Dismiss event is now available for filing on jointly administered member cases. If the movant is seeking dismissal of the lead case or the lead case and ALL member cases, the motion to dismiss should be filed in the lead case. Otherwise, the motion should be filed in the specific member case(s) that the movant is seeking to dismiss.

Personal Identifiers (WO 6267) [All Users]

The redaction fee is applicable to an entire case, rather than to just one document. The Motion to Remove Document and Motion to Restrict Public Access events have been updated to allow users to select more than one document, including claims, for redaction. The Motion to Restrict Public Access event only charges a fee when asking to redact personal identifiers.

Appeals (WO 6252) [Court Users]

The Acknowledgement of Transcript Request event now sends an email to the Appeals group when related to an appeal. The Transmittal event was updated to allow the user to attach any deficiency notices or orders when transmitting the appeal to District Court for the first time. All transmittals after the first one require the District Court case number to be added to docket text. When a Notice of Incomplete Filing is issued for failure to pay the Appeal filing fee, a form is created and attached to the entry (usually this event is a docket only entry), allowing the notice to be transmitted to District Court when necessary.

Current Monthly Income re: Bug Fix (WO 6277) [Court Users]

The variable that captures the current monthly income from the B22 forms was misspelled. The variable name has been corrected, and the current monthly income is being added to the database correctly.
