

## **Motion Pursuant to Fed.R.Bankr.P. 7042 (WO 6255) [All Users]**

This new motion event is now available, along with a related order event. The Motion to Consolidate Cases event has been restricted to bankruptcy cases.

## **Proof of Claim Quality Control (WO 6292) [All Users]**

The Court will no longer review claims for accuracy in filing. A message has been added to ECF warning filers that they are responsible for ensuring claims are filed in the correct cases.

## **Miscellaneous Proceedings re: Personal Identifiers (WO 6302) [All Users]**

Creditors seeking to remove documents with personal identifiers from multiple cases can ask the Court to open a Miscellaneous Proceeding and run a program that auto-dockets the motions, privatizes the original documents, and files replacement documents. To help with that process the events used to open a Miscellaneous Proceeding have been updated to include filer information in docket text, and the Motion to Remove Document event has been updated to skip the fee when docketed on a Miscellaneous Proceeding. The filing fees for the Miscellaneous Proceeding and the auto-docketed motions are added to ECF after the proceeding is opened but before the motions are auto-docketed.

## **Team Leader Email Added to Events (WO 4915) [Court Users]**

Events have been updated to send the team leaders an email when the following happens:

- Plan or Amended Plan is withdrawn or stricken
  - Order Granting Motion for Relief from Dismissal Order is vacated

## **Assign Docket Processing Function (DPF) re: NextGen (WO 6291) [Court Users]**

The Assign DPF allows court users to relate hearings to other events so that hearing information is displayed correctly in NextGen. Only programming changes are going LIVE at this time. Events that schedule hearings will be reviewed, discussed with courtroom deputies, and then updated at some point prior to going LIVE on NextGen.

## **Report of Sale Events re: Bug Fix (WO 6304) [Court Users]**

An old Report of Sale event on the trustees' menu wasn't set up correctly -- it came with the Starter Dictionary and wasn't updated when the Local Rules were updated. The event came to light when a Report of Sale deadline wasn't auto-terminated when the Report of Sale was filed. The old event has been retired, and the newer Report of Sale event has been added to the trustees' menu.
