

ePOC Program Update (WO 5877) [All Users]

The Electronic Proof of Claim Filing program (ePOC) has been updated. All changes are behind the scenes, so users won't see any differences during filing.

Credit Card Lock-Out Program (WO 6285) [All Users]

This program has been updated so that a second Notice of Incomplete Filing will be issued when an attorney is locked out for failure to pay when a new fee has been added to an existing entry. This situation comes up when an installment fee petition is filed incorrectly, the full filing fee is removed, and an installment fee payment is added.

IsValue and IsVariable Functions (WO 2088) [All Users]

The locally developed IsVal and IsVar functions are being merged with the national IsValue and IsVariable functions, and small groups of updated events are being periodically moved to LIVE. Users should not notice any changes to the updated events, but if problems occur, contact the Court. Updated events:

- Block Scheduling Notice
 - Notice of Change of Address
 - Notice of Conversion to Chapter 7
 - Notice of Dismissal of Adversary Proceeding, Party or Count
 - Stipulation of Dismissal of Adversary Proceeding, Party or Count
 - Notice of Requirements Upon Conversion to Chapter 7 (court notice)
 - Objection Notice (court notice)

Reopened Cases re: Trustee Robert Brothers (WO 6389) [Court Users]

When a closed case is reopened where Robert Brothers is the trustee, an email will be sent to the 341 Group so the U.S. Trustee can be contacted about appointing a new trustee.

Auto-Terminate Wage Assignments Program (WO 6393) [Court Users]

If a case has two or more pending wage assignments for the same employer, the program was relating the Order Terminating Wage Assignment to all entries, which caused the order to fail. The program has been updated to only relate the order to the last wage assignment and terminate statuses only for other wage assignments.

Log File Errors (WO 6392) [IT Staff]

Errors showing up in log files were caused by extra parentheses in a function. The parentheses problem has been resolved and error messages will no longer show up in log files.
