

Withdrawn Chapter 13 Plans (WO 6407) [Court Users]

The Withdraw Document event has been updated to auto-remove the PlanNoticePrepared? flag when a chapter 13 plan is withdrawn. This change will prevent the Plan Notice from being auto-created.

Pro Bono Application Event (WO 6406) [Court Users]

Currently, when a pro bono application is received, it is saved in the L: drive, which can make it cumbersome to retrieve. A new Pro Bono Application event is now available and the applications will be docketed. The docket entry will be public, but the PDF will be restricted to court users only, and the event is auto-QCed. The Pro Bono Case Note event was also updated to add it to the Adversary>Court Events>Miscellaneous menu and auto-QC the event.

Updated Utility Events (WO 6390) [Court Users]

The Set/Terminate Objection/Response Deadline utility event was updated to use the newest version of the Assign DPF, which assigns a deadline created in the utility event to an existing entry. The Set/Terminate Hearings/Meetings event has been retired; users can create hearing deadlines using the Create a Calendar Event for a Case menu option.

Status Record Problem (WO 6409) [Court Users]

The Awaiting Financial Management Notice status (AwFmc) is set when the 341 notice is issued. On converted cases, two status records were being created, with the second record missing information. In some instances, only one record was created with missing information. The EditAutoAssign program (which auto-issues 341 notices) and the Appoint/Terminate Trustee & Issue 341 Notice event have been updated, and records with missing information are no longer being created. The existing “bad” records will be deleted.

PDF Header Problem re: Create Record on Appeal (WO 6408) [Court Users]

PDF headers need to be turned off when the Record on Appeal is created for District Court. Unchecking the “Include headers when displaying PDF documents” box on the Docket Report didn’t remove PDF headers if the “Add Headers to PDF Documents” box in the user’s record was still checked. The program has been updated and users only need to uncheck the “Include headers when displaying PDF documents” box to ensure PDF headers are not included in the Record on Appeal.
