

Motion to Remove Document (WO 6300) [All Users]

A case does not need to be reopened to file a Motion to Remove Document. A message stating that fact is now displayed for outside users whenever the Motion to Reopen Bankruptcy Case event is selected for filing.

Appeal Events (WO 6415) [All Users]

The following changes have been made to appeal events:

- The Notice of Appeal and Amended Notice of Appeal events can now be related to more than one order entry.
 - The Answer in Opposition to Motion for Leave to Appeal event has been changed into a stopper event with a message telling users to file the answer in District Court.
 - The Motion for Leave to Appeal event was updated to change the answer deadline to a docket-text only deadline since the Bankruptcy Court won't be monitoring the deadline.
 - The Transmittal event can now be related to the Motion for Leave to Appeal event and the District Court case number is now optional.

Scheduled Reports re: Log File Errors (WO 6410) [Court Users]

An error is recorded to the Scheduled Reports log file when a report is missing an email address. Users often remove their email address to stop receiving reports, so the Scheduled Reports cron job has been updated to auto-delete any report set up without an email address.

Auto-Discharges re: Bug Fix (WO 6413) [Court Users]

The Motion for Entry of Chapter 13 Discharge event sets statuses to ensure the Certifications of Eligibility for Discharge are filed for both debtors on a joint case. If one of these statuses is pending, the case won't be auto-discharged. A problem in the event that left the statuses pending has been corrected.

E-Orders re: Deleting Trashed Orders (WO 6416) [Court Users]

Replaced orders should be auto-deleted from e-Orders, but that wasn't happening. A programming change has been made and replaced orders will now be auto-deleted.

Missing Text Field on NEF re: Claims Upload (WO 6418) [Court Users]

When an amended claim is filed through Claims Upload, the claimant name is omitted from the text version of NEF. The problem has been fixed and the claimant name is no longer omitted.
