

## **Forms Modernization Project re: End of Grace Period (WO 6401) [All Users]**

Official bankruptcy forms were updated nationally on 12/1/15, and our Court allowed filers a 60-day grace period to continue filing schedules on old forms on cases filed prior to 12/1/15. That grace period ends on February 1st and the following events have been retired or updated to remove reference to old forms: Exhibit D; Amended Schedules; Corrected Amended Schedules; Schedule(s) - Incomplete Filings Only.

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## **Notice of Consultation Requirement in New Albany Division (WO 6474) [All Users]**

The chapter 13 trustee in the New Albany Division requires debtors to contact him within 21 days of filing an objection to the trustee's motion to dismiss. The Notice of Consultation Requirement was previously issued by the court, but noticing duties have now been shifted to the trustee.

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## **Claim Related Events re: Filing Information (WO 6482) [All Users]**

The following claim related events will no longer display filing party information in docket text: Notice of Fees, Expenses or Charges; Notice of Payment Change; Response to Notice of Final Cure Payment.

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## **Entry of Default by Clerk (WO 6483) [All Users]**

When an Entry of Default by Clerk was docketed, case managers did not have the ability to select who received a copy of the entry. The Forms Table has been updated, and case managers can now select who receives the entry.

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## **Case Note Event (WO 6480) [Court Users]**

The following docket text option has been added to the Case Note event: Proof of Claim was filed on behalf of creditor, but more than 30 days after expiration of claims filing deadline.

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## **Financial Emails (WO 6490) [Financial]**

The following two events have been updated to remove email notification to the financial department: Fee Due (Create Outstanding Fee); Order on Application for Waiver of Chapter 7 Filing Fee.

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
