Intervenor Role Changed Deadline (WO 6546) [Courtroom Services, Chambers]

A new deadline – Intervenor Role Changed? – has been added to the Order Granting Motion to Intervene event, to ensure that the CRDs remember to ask case managers to update the intervenor role type as needed.

Remove Document/Restrict Access Events re: Claims (WO 6558) [Court Users]

The Motion to Remove Document and the Motion to Restrict Public Access events have been updated to require users to select a claim when that option has been selected. Previously, a warning was displayed, but users could continue without selecting a claim which caused the related order to fail.

Withdraw Document Event (WO 6550) [Court Users]

This event was updated so that only deadlines in the entry being withdrawn are auto-terminated. Previously, deadlines set in entries related to the withdrawn entry were also auto-terminated.
