

Notices of Plan Completion and Trustees' Motions to Dismiss (WO 6397)

[Court Users]

The Notice of Plan Completion event has been updated to auto-terminate any pending motions to dismiss filed by the trustee. Terminating the motions will allow the auto-discharge and auto-closing programs to process more chapter 13 cases.

Administrative Reopening Order and Retired Judges (WO 6433) [Court Users]

This order event has been updated to randomly select another judge when a case assigned to a retired judge is being administratively reopened.

Order Events Updated to Prevent Form Failure (WO 6391) [Courtroom Services]

The following order events have been updated to allow users to relate the order to just one other entry. When more than one entry is related, the form fails. Updating the events will prevent future form failures.

 - Order Mooting Objection

Order Setting or Continuing Hearing or Trial (WO 6481) [Courtroom Services]

The Order on Motion to Set Hearing and the Order on Motion to Continue Hearing events have been updated to ask users if a hearing or trial is being scheduled. This question was previously available for CRDs, but was removed during a recent update.

Order Extending Time to File Miscellaneous Documents/Installment Payments (WO 6568) [Courtroom Services]

When this order is entered on an installment fee case, the user is asked if more time is being requested to make installment payments. Answering Yes to this question sets up an installment fee deadline, which triggers the issuance of a Notice of Pending Dismissal if fees aren't paid. To ensure that the correct deadline (e.g., extension of time or installment fee) is set, a warning message is displayed if the user answers Yes to the installment fee question.
