AMENDED ORDER

[changes from original order appear in **bold**]

Any entity (other than an attorney, a pro se debtor, or a petition preparer) filing more than ten (10) **paper** documents in bankruptcy cases or proceedings per calendar year shall be required to **file electronically either by registering** as a limited user pursuant to the Court's ECF Administrative Policies and Procedures Manual¹ **or by using ePOC/eWOC to file, amend, and/or withdraw proofs of claim.** Thereafter, the entity shall file all documents electronically. Failure to register or to use electronic filing **or ePOC/eWOC** may result in an order to show cause and the rejection of paper filings.

The Clerk shall give notice by mail of this general order to affected entities, using filing information for calendar year 2009. This general order becomes effective as to any entity 30 days after notice is sent. The Clerk shall begin providing notice on or after December 1, 2009.
