**NOTICE OF AMENDMENTS TO
NATIONAL RULES AND FORMS**

Several amendments to the Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure and to the Official Forms become effective December 1, 2010. Here is a link to information about these changes:

Locally, these new Rules and forms will result in the following changes:

1. Creation of a new Motion Objecting to Discharge event, for use when denial of discharge is sought under 11 U.S.C. Sections 727(a)(8) or (9) or 1328(f). FRBP 4004 and 7001.
2. Acknowledgment in forms and practice of the additional 15 days given for filing proof that the financial management course has been completed. FRBP 1007.
3. Changes to properly calculate the deadline for objecting to exemptions when a case has converted. FRBP 1019.
4. Creation of a new Involuntary Creditor List event for use by the debtor after the order of relief has been granted. FRBP 1007.
5. Local practice anticipated the requirement of notice to debtors about their failure to file proof of financial management course, but the notice has only been issued in Chapter 7 cases. It will now be issued in Chapter 13 cases as well. FRBP 5009.
